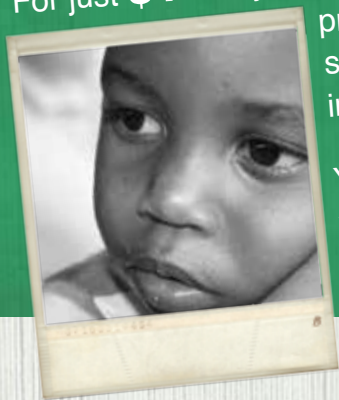




# Sponsor a Child

Impoverished, **orphaned children** have a dim future without help. They are often sold into slavery and abused. We can help them, **ONE AT A TIME**.

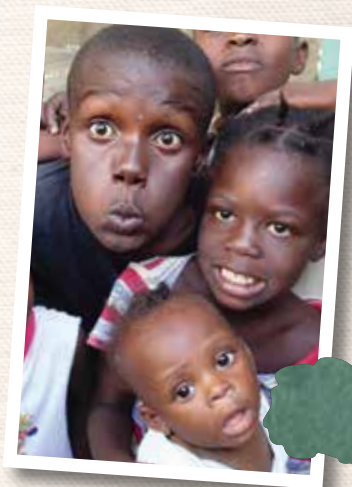

Through their nutritional feeding program, Christian education and sister ministries, they are helping the orphaned and extremely impoverished children become strong, Christ-centered leaders who will bring about help and hope for their country. ### 201 | Vitamins For A Malnourished Child

• \$2

Provide shots, de-worming medications and vitamins for a malnourished Haitian child. Our partner visits and distributes consistent medication to these children. Join us and show God's great love to these desperate children.

• \$2.50

Just \$2.50 covers a clinic consult, minor procedures and all medications. For dental patients, it covers a cleaning, medications and any fillings or extractions needed.





## 206 | Creole Bible

• \$5

Creole Bibles are in high demand in Haiti. These Bibles will be given to those who come to the clinic, to pastors for their congregations and to anyone who is in need of one. For a gift of \$5, you can put one of the greatest gifts of all in the hands of a Haitian.



## 207 | Milk Supplements

• \$25

Families are in dire need of baby formula for children who have lost a mother or whose mother's milk has dried up from malnourishment. A gift of \$25 will give supplements to malnourished children, babies and also supplements for mothers.



## 208 | Benches

## 209 | Clean Water Well

• \$1, \$10, \$100, or \$2,250

Every twenty seconds a child dies from a water-related disease. Every year over 2.2 million children under age

5 die from starvation and preventable diseases. One of the main causes is that they do not have access to clean water. For \$2,250 you can give the gift of a tube

well for a village. Each well provides clean water to

thousands of people living in that village. A gift of only \$1 can provide 1 person with clean water for life. \$10 provides 10 people with clean water and \$100 provides 100 people with clean water!



## What Happens When You GIVE

- You will receive pictures of your water well and the village you have impacted, as well as the GPS coordinates of the location of the well.
- If you give \$1500 or more to build a well, your name can be on a plaque inscribed near the well.
- You are welcome to join us on a GPartners trip to dedicate the well!

## 210 | Cloth Dying Start-Up Cost

• \$50

A unique way to help bring hope to a family living in poverty is to provide them with the training and materials needed to start their own cloth-dying business with a gift of only \$50!



## 211 | Goat

• \$100

Goats can be a blessing to a family that is suffering from malnutrition and poverty. This animal can be used to supply food (milk, butter, etc.) for the family and surplus milk. Offspring can be sold for income to help the family survive. For just \$100, you can bring hope to a family.



Sherkanta has been working hard to earn a sewing machine and start her own business by making skirts for our Nations Hope Store.

"I do not want my four children, one with a handicap, to have the same trouble as me. I want them to advance in life and their studies so they are able to get good jobs. I work in a cleaning factory from 9am-7pm making less than \$2 a day for my family. I am persecuted for my faith in my village, as they want me to return to Hinduism." **You can help someone like Sherkanta!**

# Jordan



**HELP IRAQI & SYRIAN  
REFUGEES TODAY.**

Imagine having to flee your home, family and work at a moment's notice and end up in a place where you don't know anyone, don't know where you will stay and have absolutely no opportunities for income or for your children's education. This is the plight of refugees fleeing persecution and civil war in the countries of Syria and Iraq. More than half a million of them have fled to the neighboring country of Jordan. When they arrive they must rely on local charities to help meet their basic needs. During this most traumatic time of their lives, we have the opportunity to provide help and hope to these hurting families.







### 223 | Care for Syrian Refugees

• \$10, \$20, or \$40

The civil war in neighboring Syria has driven about half a million people to Jordan. Most are women and children.

The refugees need immediate help. Blankets (\$10), mattresses (\$20) and heaters (\$40) are a good start. Help someone sleeping on a cold, concrete floor experience a bit of comfort.



### 224 | Food Box for a Refugee Family

• \$30

GPPD has been showing and sharing God's love by helping meet some of the refugees' most basic needs. A

gift of \$30 will provide a refugee family with rice, sugar, tea, macaroni, oil and a small can of meat.



### 225 | Christmas Gift for a Refugee Child

• \$10

Each year our Associates provide Christmas gifts to more than 200 children. Most children would not receive a gift

because their families are struggling to provide for their basic needs. A gift of \$10 will pay for a toy, a clothing item and a New Testament.



## 226 | Diapers, Milk and Baby Formula

• \$20

As most refugees are struggling to provide food for their family, they are unable to purchase diapers and milk or baby formula for their young children. For a gift of \$20, you can provide diapers and powdered milk or baby formula for a needy child for a month.



## 227 | Prenatal Care for Expectant Moms

• \$50

Syrian refugees typically have large families. As they struggle to find food to eat, expectant moms do not get the proper care they need and deserve. With a gift of \$50, we're able to provide medical checkups, prenatal vitamins, hospital referrals and family support for expectant mothers.



## 228 | Refrigerator for a Refugee Family

• \$150

Without a refrigerator, families are reduced to survival-type living. Day after day they go to the market, purchase food, cook it, eat it and throw away leftovers because they can't keep them. Many have small children and have nowhere to put milk and medications that require refrigeration. For only \$150, you can buy a used refrigerator and bring hope to a family in need.





## 229 | Community Center and Church for Refugees

• \$50, \$500

Many renovations and expanded facilities are needed for the community center we purchased two years ago in Jordan. The center is a place where many hurting refugees find physical, emotional and spiritual help. It's a place where they can learn, grow and develop as they start the path to immigration. Two new floors will allow for more housing for both refugees and aid workers. With your help we will have greater opportunities and more available space to help even more refugee families. About \$50,000 is needed to complete these renovations.



Adnan and his family lived near the city of Mosul in Iraq their entire lives. He received death threats from ISIS jihadists, and when his car was shot at six times, Adnan moved quickly to get out. He and his wife, three children, sister-in-law and her two children all came to Jordan. They were referred to GPPD's Community Center where they received aid. Now they are living across the street from the center and are very involved with the ministry.

# Slovakia



## EDUCATION

### Narnia School

Because English is highly valued in Slovakia, our GPPD Associates are using the tool of education to show and share God's love to **ONE STUDENT AT A TIME**. One of our partners in Slovakia is an elementary school called Narnia. They offer integrated thematic education and extensive English language training. Because English is so highly valued, they attract many

students. There are many ways **YOU CAN DO SOMETHING** to help this school share God's love with their students and families.







### 230 | School Fee Discount

• \$30

Narnia Elementary School is a private school that requires a monthly fee. The discounted fee is half the monthly charge for the students. Thanks to this gift, kids from poorer families, often with more siblings also attending the school, can afford private education and are not forced to go to a public school.



### 231 | School Activity

• \$15

Not all the students from the Narnia Elementary School can afford the extra-curricular school activities, e.g. school trips, excursions, weekend activities at the school, etc. In such cases these kids have to stay home and cannot participate in these activities. Your gift of \$15 gives one student an opportunity to take part in one of these school activities.



### 232 | Sports and Afternoon Club Equipment

• \$25

Your gift of \$25 will help provide sports and afternoon club equipment for students at Narnia. The school needs equipment for various sports for PE classes and playground activities. In the afternoon they offer clubs for students whose parents both work. Under the economic system in Slovakia, it is generally required that both parents work. Your gift will also equip the afternoon clubs with activities, games and other educational items.



### 233 | Slovak Bibles

• \$15

The Bible is the greatest gift we can give. Most Slovaks struggle to make ends meet and cannot afford a complete Bible in their own language. For a gift of \$15, you can buy a hardback Bible for a person who desires to learn more about God.

## 235 | Solar Power Charging Micro-Business

• \$50 or \$200

Around 1.5 billion of the world's population lacks access to reliable electricity. This is very true for many living in Uganda and East Africa. Having a solar panel unit not only provides electricity for the family, but it also becomes an opportunity to start a business. People from all over their community will come to their home and pay a very small fee to charge their cell phones. This business can provide a family approximately half of the income each month that they need to survive. A gift of \$200 will provide a family with one of these solar powered units.
