

We encourage a fundraising goal of \$3000 per marathon relay team. Visit our website or scan the QR code on the front to get started! Take on the challenge this historic year!













IN 2016, REV HOME STARTED IN PORT-AU-PRINCE, HAITI. MANY OF YOU KNOW THE STORY WELL. AMBER HASSON TOOK OVER A PROGRAM THAT WAS HELPING OVER 40 CHILDREN WITH HOUSING, EDUCATION, AND MORE. REV UNITED

Founded by Ludjer, a REV graduate, this club gives local kids much more than athletic training. He prays with them, teaches them about character, teamwork, and dreaming big. He provides a safe space in the middle of the war zone that is Portau-Prince. The team's motto is "viv rev nou" which translates to "living our dream." Not only that, they're really good. They are continually winning local tournaments and this year were invited to play in one of Haiti's biggest tournaments. Funds that we direct to Ludjer from this outing will go to player fees, food and water, and new equipment.







GRACE FOR HAITI'S CHILDREN



Founded in 2019 by REV graduate Murielle Valme, this Christ-centered nonprofit equips underserved Haitian children and families through equitable access to education. essential resources, and community support. Her compassionate mission fosters dignity and hope through transformational programs. She is currently working to build a community center in one of the more dangerous parts of Port-au-Prince where most of the kids she serves live. Funds that we direct to her from this outing will go directly to that!

THE HAITIAN RUBY PROJECT

Led by REV graduate Jovenel Pierre, the Haitian Ruby Project promotes unity, dignity, and purposeful community-building. Their outreach includes street-cleaning initiatives, recycling efforts, and arts-based programs, all aimed at nurturing pride, stewardship, and service in neighborhoods across Haiti. Jovenel is now meeting with local schools to get students around Port-au-Prince involved in their community programs. Funds directed to Jovenel from this outing will go directly towards their first school-based street-cleaning.
